"The CFF's Stair Climb fundraiser was a HUGE success that took place over two evenings. The first night was for 100 firefighters who climbed the 56 flights of stairs in full gear that weighed 146 lbs. The winner made it in just under 9 minutes. The second night had 600 people doing the same race. Our **TASC force team** provided big smiles, Caesar salad, spaghetti with meat sauce, rotelle with Alfredo sauce and we also provided BJ's Blonde and Jeremiah Red beers per the special request of our firefighters. Allison's Angels and the CF Foundation raised a ton of money for CF research and we can't wait to do it again next year!"

"Our **TASC Force team** helped raise over \$3700 for Cameron's Crew. We kicked off the walk at 9 a.m. to experience all the festivities they had available for children affected by Autism. About 15 of us from the restaurant met up at 10:30 and participated in the walk. We had beautiful weather (for Ohio) which helped with the turnout. As a whole the walk had over 15,000 walkers and raised over \$650,000. To raise money we had a donation event at the restaurant as well as making puzzle piece earrings for donations."
